KEY FINDINGS OF THE SURVEY

CONCERNING THE ALBANIAN YOUTH KNOWLEDGE ABOUT THE EUROPEAN UNION

How is the Albanian youth informed about the European Union? What do they think about the future of Albania's EU membership and what are the aspects that make this membership difficult? These are some questions of the survey conducted in 11 areas of Albania, within the framework of the project "Building the European Future at home – Youth engagement in the process".

The purpose of this questionnaire was to obtain information on the knowledge the Albanian youth has about the European Union, in order to assess the needs for building their knowledge and skills related to this topic. The analysis of the answers provided also served as the basis for the preparation of a Training Manual for the youth in Albania.

In the survey conducted during April-May 2019, a total of 1335 youth, aged 12 to 19 participated, 60% of whom were female and 40% male. The survey was conducted in 11 different areas of Albania (Bulqiza, Dibra, Durres, Elbasan, Kurbin, Lezha, Librazhd, Korça, Shkodra, Tirana and Vlora). Elbasan (18%), Durres (13%) and Tirana (11%) had the highest number of participants.
