The conflict in Ukraine on 24th of Feb 2022 has caused the world's fastest growing displacement crisis since World War II, leaving at least:



- **18 million** People in urgent need of humanitarian assistance in Ukraine
- **6.0 million** Refugees from Ukraine recorded across Europe
- **5.1 million** Internally displaced people

Deliver inclusive, need driven humanitarian assistance to refugees, IDPs and the most vulnerable children and their families in Ukraine, Romania, Moldova and Georgia.

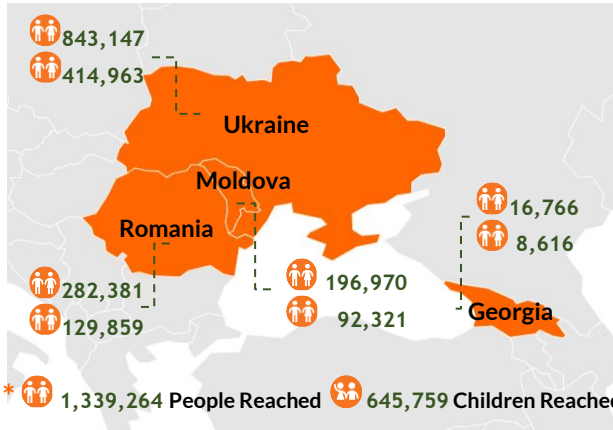
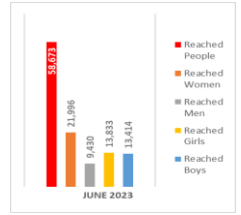
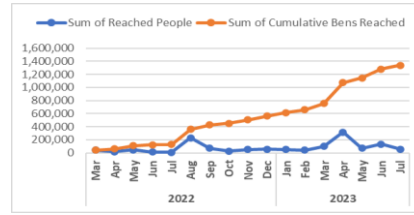
Deliver life-saving in-kind and cash assistance to meet basic food, shelter and WASH needs;

Contribute to the provision of inclusive, equitable and quality education for children.

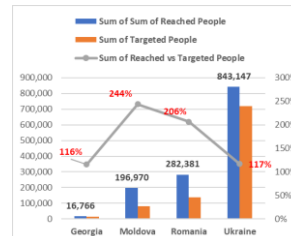
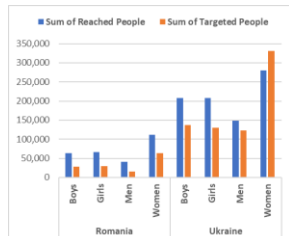
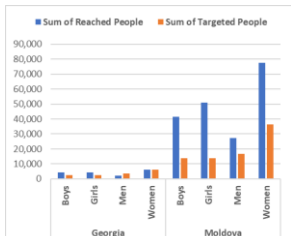


World Vision UCR:

- Works with **53** partners & donors;
- Operates in **24** regions in Ukraine, **15** in Romania, **34** in Moldova, and **4** in Georgia.
- **58,673** people were reached in June 2023, this is **4.4%** of the overall people reached to date;
- In the reporting period has reached people in:
 - Ukraine **43,404** (74% of the overall people reached in June 2023),
 - Romania - **7,505** (13%),
 - Moldova - **6,308** (11%),
 - Georgia - **1,456** (2%);
- Reached people vs targeted people accounted **141%**.
- All the countries have surpassed the original 2-year response plan targets and the beneficiaries' new targets will be revised in the next strategy update.

People reached by Sector:

- I Food Security- **33.2%**
- II Multi-purpose cash - **23.6%**
- III NFIs- **18.1%**
- IV Education - **16.9%**
- V Protection - **7.5%**
- VI Health/ Livelihoods - **0.4%**

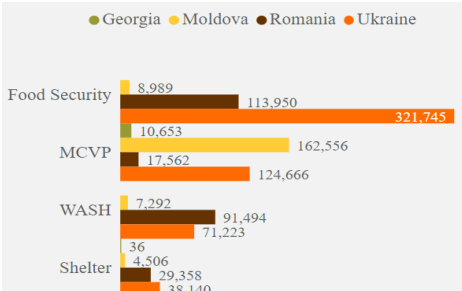

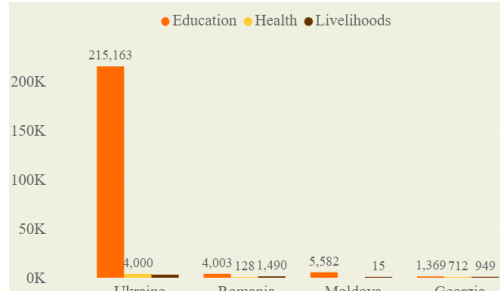

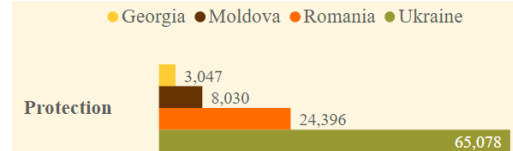
